Nestling in the Cheshire countryside, the Village is generally regarded as one of the most pleasant places to live in the UK offering an outstanding quality of life, this is due to the wide range of facilities on offer, beautiful surrounding countryside, superb commuter links, and friendly community feel.

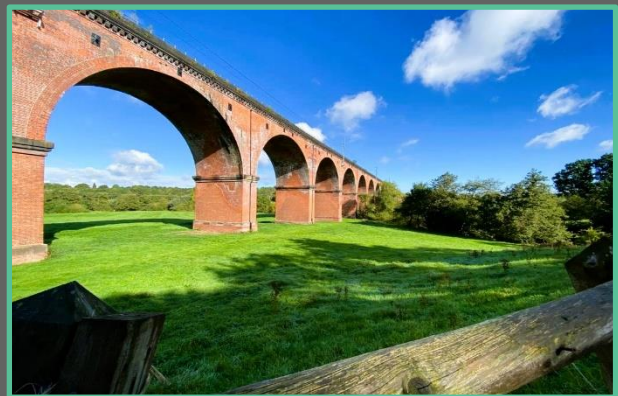
Holmes Chapel, also known as Church Hulme, was originally named Hulme, derived from Hulmor Holm, meaning rising ground. Holmes Chapel lies just South of the river Dane and many properties in the area enjoy views over the river plain.

At the heart of the village is the historic church of St Luke, this is only one of three buildings to survive the great fire of 1753, evidence of the scorching can still be seen on the lime trees within the churchyard today.

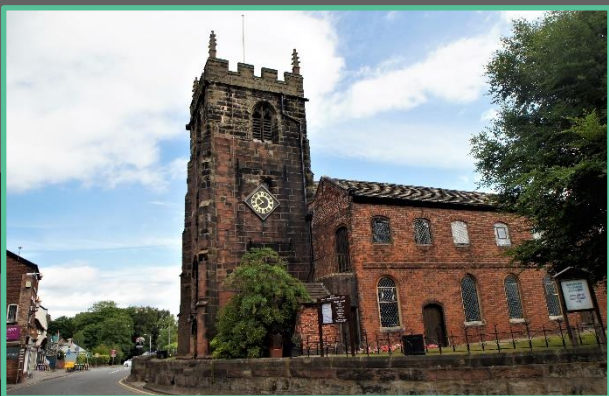
Since then the village has been re-built and expanded and over the course of time many new houses have appeared and spread the population over a wide area. The majority of housing was constructed since the late 1960s, however a good proportion of property towards the town centre is Victorian/Edwardian.

There are two impressive local landmarks in the area: A testament to the Victorian era in the form of the Holmes Chapel railway viaduct, built in 1840, which dominates the landscape at Twemlow.

The Jodrell Bank telescope can be seen for miles around, located on the Cheshire plains just outside Goostrey, it is currently Europe's largest radio telescope and responsible for many astronomical discoveries.



SHOPPING & LEISURE



Holmes chapel offers far more than one might expect from a village of its size with a wide range of independent and highstreet shops, many of which are family run and very friendly, briefly they include: bakers, butchers, supermarkets, off license, post-office, bookmakers, solicitors, hairdressers, dry cleaners, florists, opticians, library, health centre, coffee shops, vets, an agricultural supplier and of course estate agents! A business park is located on the edge of the village which also offers a range of services such as a children's play centre and of course the famous Morreys DIY centre. With further extensive shopping facilities located a short distance away at either Northwich, Winsford, Sandbach, Crewe or Macclesfield.

The Holmes Chapel area also offers many leisure facilities including a superb range of restaurants, public houses and takeaway outlets. Other facilities include a wide range of clubs, societies, and events organised locally through the Holmes Chapel leisure centre with excellent sports facilities, and also through local village halls. Numerous golf courses and extensive publicly accessed countryside, lakes and stately homes can be located within a short drive.
